Oath taking of newly hired lawyers of the Bureau of Working Conditions



Dr. Ma. Teresita S. Cucueco, Bureau Director, administered the oath taking of newly hired lawyers of the Bureau of Working Conditions (BWC) in her Office on 26 September 2017.

The newly elected lawyers are Attorneys Michael Duane D. Navales (left most in photo), from a BPO company, and Joharic A. Maligaya (middle of photo) from the Securities and Exchange Commission. They will both occupy the Attorney III position of the Bureau.

Among their primary functions as Attorney III are: (1) assist in the preparation of draft decisions of appealed labor cases/administrative cases for consideration of the Secretary of Labor; (2) Conducts conciliations, investigations and/or hearing on labor, employment or administrative disciplinary cases and submits findings/recommendations thereon; (3) conducts researches and studies on specific legal questions or issues in relation to the functions of the Office; (4) assists in representing the office before the judiciary, legislative bodies and other legal entities and many more.
