### **HANDS-ON TRAINING ON THE NEW MIS PLATFORM WAS CONDUCTED NATIONWIDE**

A total of sixteen (16) DOLE Regional Offices were visited to orient Labor Inspectors with the new Management Information System (MIS) Mobile and Web Application. All members of the MIS Team from the Bureau simultaneously and continuously conducted hands-on training on different regions nationwide in less than a month.



Relative to the conduct of labor inspection and in accordance with Department Order No. 183, Series of 2017 (DO 183-17), a mobile and web application was developed to contain a more comprehensive checklist of laws that must be complied by establishments. The new MIS mobile and web application is an online, web-based application system that utilizes information technology for the transmission and processing of real-time data collection from the field using electronic checklist. With the said system, technology will be utilized in order to immediately record workplace inspection results.

Starting this year, all labor inspection activities of inspectors are expected to encode and sync their activity with the new system. This upgrade to the inspection system was made not only to simplify and improve the conduct of inspection but as well as to improve the Bureau's collection and sharing of information, administrative transparency and accountability.
