### DOLE Going the Extra Mile



Undersecretary Joel B. Maglunsod, together with a representative from the Bureau of Working Conditions (BWC), Occupational Safety and Health Center (OSHC), DOLE Region 3 and DOLE CAMANAVA attended a series of labor consultations organized by the Mariveles Ecumenical Workers Desk and Workers' Movement for Change.

The first leg of the labor consultation was organized by the Mariveles Ecumenical Workers Desk held on April 8, 2018 in Mariveles, Bataan. Whilst the second and third leg was organized by the Workers' Movement for Change held on April 21 and 22 in Castillejos, Zambales and Valenzuela City, respectively.

Questions raised by the participants in these labor consultations primarily revolved around the topic on general labor standards and execution of compliance orders and decisions issued by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE).

Attendees to the above labor consultations were guaranteed that their concerns are being heard and that the Department is making the necessary actions in order to resolve their grievances and concerns.

The fourth and last leg of the labor consultation was set on May 13, 2018 in Castillejos, Zambales which will also be organized by the Workers' Movement for Change.
