BATCH V TRAINING FOR SOCIAL PARTNERS TO BE HELD NEXT MONTH

Upon the directive of Undersecretary Joel B. Maglunsod, Batch V training for social partners/sectoral representative on labor laws and social legislations was set to be held next month, June 18 to 28.

Despite the issues raised during the Batch IV Luzon training, participants from the said batch still gave a positive rating for the over-all conduct of the training and thanked the Department of Labor and Employment for the opportunity given to them to become capacitated social partners on labor laws and social legislations.

The Technical Working Group for the training of social partners was immediately called to convene after Usec. Maglunsod gave its go signal to start the preparatory activities for the training.

Participants from the labor and employer sectors in all industries are once again expected to partake in the upcoming activity such as those from the fishing, BPO and construction industry.

The training for social partners or sectoral representatives was made pursuant to Administrative Order No. 164, Series of 2017 (AO 164-17).

AO 164-17 pertains to the participation of social partners or sectoral representatives in the conduct of inspection of establishments' compliance to labor laws and social legislations including attendance to mandatory conferences.

Joint efforts and coordination are being exerted by several offices with the objective of capacitating participants with the knowledge and skills needed to assist labor inspectors during the conduct of inspection of establishments.
