Director Ma. Teresita S. Cucueco of the Bureau of Working Conditions, along with Atty. Gerard Peter C. Mariano of the Bureau of Workers with Special Concerns and Atty. Kristine Dacuyan-Eugenio of the Social Security System, presented the salient features of Republic Act No. 11210, otherwise known as the 105-Day Expanded Maternity Leave Law, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations before an audience of more than one hundred (100) participants attended by mostly human resource practitioners.

The learning session, organized by the Learning and Organization Development Institute, Inc.
