BWC JOINS SSS IN ORIENTING HR PRACTITIONERS AND EMPLOYERS

In light of the issuance of Republic Act (RA) No. 11210, otherwise known as the 105-Day Expanded Maternity Leave Law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the members of the Inter-Agency Steering Committee involved in the formation of the IRR has been continuously receiving numerous requests to conduct seminar on the subject matter.

To address the concern of these requests, the SSS organized a weekly In-House Information Seminar from May 2019 to July 2019 and is expected to be attended by more or less five hundred (500) participants per session.

The SSS is part of the Inter-Agency Steering Committee (ISC) who formulated the IRR of RA No. 11210. Other agencies involved in the said formulation are the Civil Service Commission and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE). Representation of DOLE to the said ISC was lead by the Office of the Undersecretary for Labor Relations, Special Concerns and Regional Operations Cluster and support offices are the Bureau of Workers with Special Concerns and the Bureau of Working Conditions.
