Online DOLE Establishment Report System, underway

The DOLE-Bureau of Working Conditions has always prioritized the safety and health of its stakeholders in all of its undertakings. This was the very reason for its soon to be launched program on the establishments' submission of report.

The DOLE Establishment Report System was conceptualized to assist establishment in its submission of reports to DOLE Regional, Provincial, and Field Offices having jurisdiction over the workplace. This was made possible through the collective effort and collaboration of the information and technology personnel of Bureau and that of the DOLE National Capital Region under the guidance of Undersecretary Ana C. Dione and OIC-Assistant Secretary Ma. Teresita S. Cucueco.

“As the country transitions to a new normal amid the COVID-19 pandemic, we continue to find ways to provide our clients with services while protecting their health, safety and well-being and those of employees of the DOLE,” said OIC-Asec. Cucueco in her remarks for the reason on the development of this online reporting system.

This online reporting system was developed to allow companies to comply with the documentary requirements for submission under the Labor Code, Occupational Safety and Health Standards and other relevant laws and issuances under the comfort of one's home and workplace.

This DOLE Establishment Reporting System shall be launched very soon. The BWC advises companies to check the website of the DOLE Regional Office having jurisdiction over them for updates and announcements.
