DOLE launches online application for CAMP

The Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) has started anew to implement CAMP under BAYANIHAN 2 as part of the government's effort nationwide in the implementation of recovery and rehabilitation measures to cushion the pandemic's impacts on the economy and society. The COVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program (CAMP) is a safety net program that provides one-time financial support to affected workers in the formal sector due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

On 30 October 2020, the DOLE issued Department Order No. 218, Series of 2020 entitled "Guidelines on the Implementation of COVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program (CAMP) under the BAYANIHAN to Recover as One Act". In line with this, the DOLE – Systems Development Team (DOLE-SDT) launched an online application system for CAMP under the supervision of Undersecretary Ana C. Dione and Assistant Secretary Ma. Teresita S. Cucueco.

The online system was developed to streamline, simplify, and digitize the submission of applications and monitoring of reports. Furthermore, this is also to reduce physical contact and ensure the safety of the public and DOLE employees as recommended by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases and the Department of Health.

The online application system may be accessed at <https://reports.dole.gov.ph>. Clients may select the "Apply for CAMP Financial Assistance" and will choose the preferred application such as: 1) Apply as Establishment; 2) Apply as DOT Accredited Establishment; and 3) Displaced and Temporarily Laid-off Workers. If applying as an establishment, the client must have an ERS account or need to register first to continue the application. And if applying as laid-off workers, the client will simply fill in the data needed. When the client has applied for CAMP, he/she can now track the progress of their application.

DOLE will continue to enhance the online system as we face this pandemic and as we adopt the new normal.
