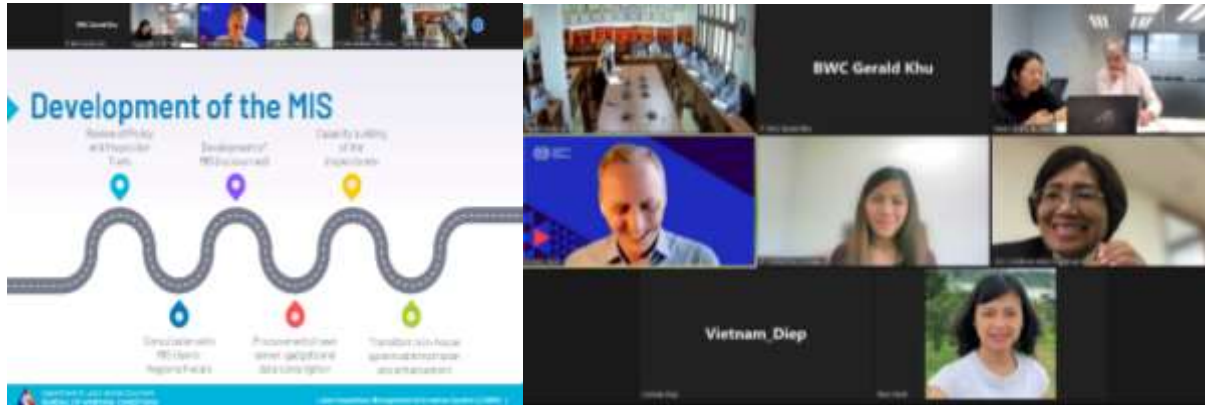

DOLE welcomes Vietnam's offer to share MIS rollout and management expertise

Viet Nam's Ministry of Labour, Invalids and Social Affairs (MOLISA), through the International Labour Organization (ILO), requested for an online meeting with the Philippines' Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) for another opportunity to learn about rolling out and managing the MIS last 09 June 2022.

DOLE representatives headed by Undersecretary Ana Dione, Engr. Kristine Carol Ramos and Mr. Gerald Khu of the Bureau of Working Conditions (BWC) met with the officials from MOLISA and the ILO Team headed by Labour Administration and Inspection Specialist Mr. Rene Robert.
