In the interest of the service and in line with the implementation of DOLE Department Order 183, Series of 2017 or the Revised Rules on the Administration and Enforcement of Labor Laws Pursuant to Article 128 of the Labor Code, as Renumbered, **General Authority** is hereby given to the Third Batch of personnel designated to conduct Routine Inspection, Complaint Inspection, Occupational Safety and Health Standards Investigation, Technical Safety Inspection and Special Inspection until 31 December 2018 unless earlier revoked.

Personnel performing Technical Safety Inspections shall also conduct Routine Inspection on establishments which are subject of their Technical Safety Inspection.

The Regional Directors shall issue the corresponding Authority to Inspect or investigate specific target establishments/workplaces. The said authority is co-terminous with the term of the General Authority, unless a shorter period is provided by the Regional Director.

In case of any incident involving disabling injury requiring immediate action, labor inspectors may be allowed to conduct initial OSHS Investigation prior to the issuance of the specific authority provided that instruction is given by the Regional Director/Field Office Head/TSSD Chief. This provisional authority is hereby conferred to all labor inspectors with general authority under this issuance and in Admin. Order Nos. 05 and 05-A, Series of 2018.
