



**Arrangement on Technical Cooperation
on Occupational Safety and Health
Between Department of Labor and Employment(DOLE) and
Korea Occupational Safety and Health Agency (KOSHA)**

Department of Labor and Employment, Republic of the Philippines, (hereinafter referred to as “**DOLE**”) with a principal place at DOLE Bldg., Intramuros, Manila, Republic of the Philippines, and **Korea Occupational Safety and Health Agency** (hereinafter referred to as “**KOSHA**”) with a principal place at 400 Jongga-ro, Jung-gu, Ulsan, 44429, Republic of Korea, decide to extend collaboration between both parties in the field of Occupational Safety and Health as a follow-on to the previous arrangement on Technical Cooperation between DOLE and KOSHA, implemented on 30th Aug. 2013 and expiring on 29th Aug. 2016. This arrangement is based on the common belief that heightened cooperation between the two organizations will contribute to enhancing individual and mutual needs.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this arrangement is to support and enhance the capability of the occupational safety and health and contribute to promoting safety and health of workers at the workplaces in both countries by establishing a cooperative relationship between DOLE and KOSHA in the field of occupational safety and health.

2. Scope

2.1 The scope of this arrangement includes the exchange of experts for training and education, consultancy, seminar/workshop or for research program on the topics of mutual interest and the exchange of technical information/materials and etc. on occupational safety and health.



2.2 DOLE and KOSHA upon mutual consent may change the scope of cooperation.

3. Implementation

- 3.1. DOLE and KOSHA will actively cooperate within available resources for the success of this cooperation.
- 3.2 Any other form of cooperation that is not stipulated in the scope of this arrangement will be implemented by mutual consent.
- 3.3 DOLE and KOSHA may exchange publications and materials concerning occupational safety and health free of charge or at a reasonable price when such a need arises.
- 3.4 An implementation plan for each year will be made through mutual consultation prior to commencement of its implementation.

4. Expenses

- 4.1 The expenses for mutual cooperation under this arrangement will be considered and apportioned on a case-to-case basis. Nevertheless, KOSHA may provide the expenses available within the KOSHA's budget.

5. Liaison

- 5.1 DOLE and KOSHA will respectively designate a contact point for communication and coordination of the cooperation throughout the implementation of this arrangement.
- 5.2 If necessary, DOLE and KOSHA will have a meeting with each other to monitor and evaluate the progress of this cooperation.



6. Period

6.1 The arrangement will take effect upon signing hereof and will be valid for three(3) years. The implementation period may be extended by mutual consent.
